MONTGOMERY COUNTY REGIONAL SEWER AND WATER DISTRICT RESOLUTION NO. 2025-01

A Resolution Affirming Ordinance 2022-02 Regarding Residential Billing Practices

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Regional Water and Sewer District (the "District") by its Ordinance No. 2011·1 (the "Rate Ordinance") and subsequently amended by Ordinances 2013·01, 2017·01, 2022·02, 2023·01 and 2024·01, adopted a schedule of rates and charges to be collected by the District from the owners of property served by the sewage works of the District and other related matters including how user charges would be calculated; and

WHEREAS, the District's Ordinance 2022-02 amended the Rate Ordinance by eliminating the option for residential users to be charged for actual water consumption for sewer billing (metered billing) and instead requires residential users to be charged a fixed charge rate; and

WHEREAS, to avoid any confusion, the District finds it necessary to affirm that its Rate Ordinance does not allow for new residential users to elect to be charged using metered billing and must be charged a fixed charge rate.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance 2022-02 provisions regarding residential user charges is affirmed. All new residential users shall be billed a fixed charge rate per month according to the District's schedule of rates and charges.

Section 2. All current residential users that previously elected and are billed using metered billing will continue to be billed a monthly Base Charge plus the Flow

Charge per 1,000 gallons of monthly water usage as set in the District's schedule of rates and charges.
